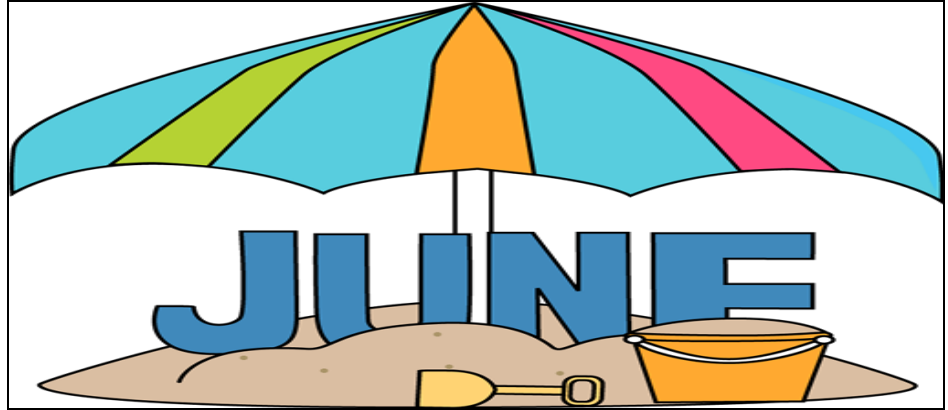

Seniors Assistance Home Maintenance (SAHM)

Do you need your grass cut, leaves raked or snow shovelled? Or, do you just need general help around your home?

Seniors Assistance Home Maintenance (SAHM) program provides assistance to seniors, as well as disabled and convalescing individuals, who need work done in and around their homes and apartments. Work includes garden and yard work, snow removal, light housekeeping and odd light jobs.

There is a fee for service brokered program where clients pay an hourly rate directly to a brokered worker on completion of the services provided.
